

Welcome to Lake Tärnasjön Fishing Camp!

a place you will always want to come back to...



There are probably no other waters in the Southern Lapland mountains which enjoy such a solid reputation for sport fishing of brown trout and arctic char as Lake Tärnasjön. This is where the Lake Tärnasjön Fishing Camp is located, close to where H.M. the King of Sweden has his private and exclusive water/fishing area.

In its pristine waters, unspoiled by hydroelectric expansion, the Sami people have been fishing for generations, at a rate favoring the natural growth of fish. By keeping up with its natural regeneration, neither depleting it, nor letting it grow too large, the result is positive for average trout and char sizes and has not created a dwarf fish population.

Lake Tärnasjön, 610 m (2000 ft) above sea level, is situated in the Vindelfjällen Nature Reserve. The area is known and of great interest to biologists and ornithologists for its variety. The rich summer blooming is overwhelming, the bird life is abundant, the views are breathtaking.

Visible from the camp is the mightiest mountain of Southern Lapland: Mt. Norra Storfjället 1767 m (5800 ft.) above sea level.

The lake holds brown trout and arctic char. Trout reaching maximum 4-5 kgs (10 lbs) and Char up to some 3 kgs (6 lbs). Catches of 4-5 lbs species are not unusual.

Hot spots: Currents and under water brinks between islands and beaches close to the camp site.

For fly fishing - some successful fly patterns: Sedges, Yellow Dun, Sedge pupae, Emergers.

For Spinning: Small spoon lures.

Lodging is in a wooden hut (cot) with room for 8-10 persons. 3 boats are available.

And don't forget to just BE there - in a very special wilderness area - a Lapland nature reserve reminiscent of a simpler, more natural life - relax and enjoy...
